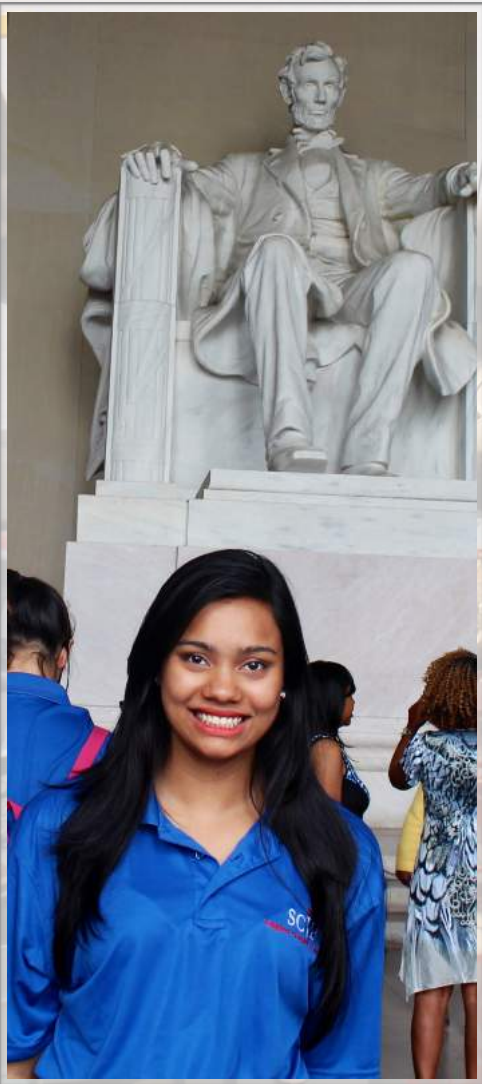
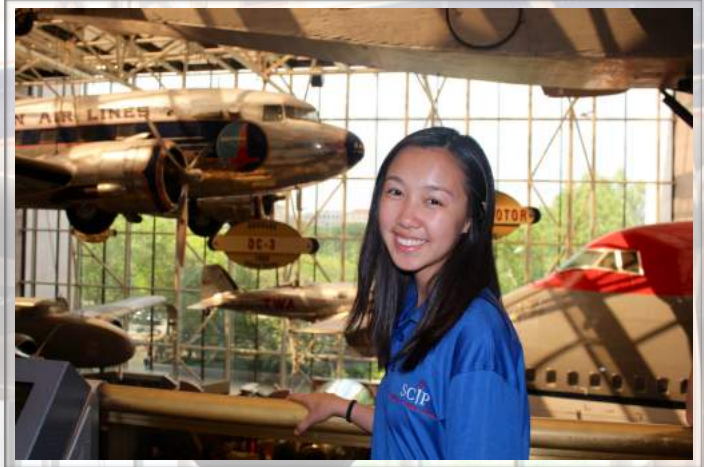
The next stop is the Korean War Veterans Memorial where SCIP Young Leaders commemorate those who served in the Korean War.

## **Final Stop:** Smithsonian Museum of Natural History and National Air and Space Museum

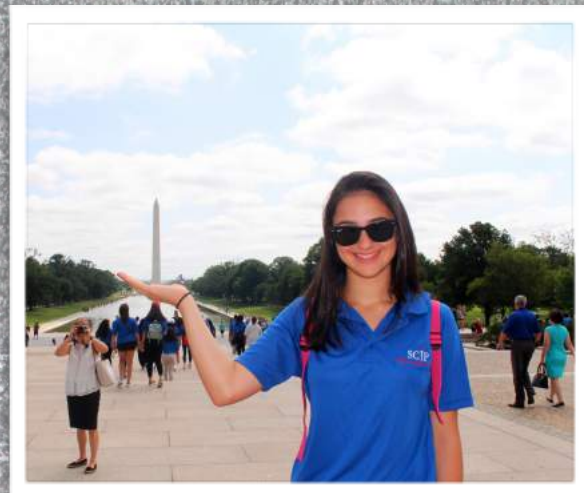




